13th ANNUAL ROYAL OAK HOLIDAY CLASSIC INVITATIONAL TOURNAMENT OFFICIAL PLAYING RULES

1. DIVISIONS WILL BE DIVIDED AS SUCH:
MITE: HOUSE TEAMS ONLY – 8 years and under
SQUIRT: HOUSE B TEAMS ONLY – 9 and 10 years old
PEE WEE: HOUSE B TEAMS ONLY – 11 and 12 years old
BANTAM: HOUSE B TEAMS ONLY – 13 and 14 years old
SQUIRT A, SQUIRT AA, PEE WEE A & PEE WEE AA

ALL TEAMS MUST PROVIDE AN APPROVED ROSTER TO THE REGISTRATION DESK PRIOR TO YOUR TEAMS FIRST GAME.
2. ALL PLAYERS MUST SIGN IN AT THE REGISTRATION DESK BEFORE EACH GAME.
3. HOME TEAM SHALL HAVE CHOICE OF JERSEY COLOR (SHOULD WEAR WHITE IF POSSIBLE). IF BOTH TEAMS HAVE LIKE JERSEY'S, VISITORS SHALL WEAR PULLOVERS.
4. EACH GAME WILL CONSIST OF 3 – 10 MINUTE STOP TIME PERIODS FOR MITE, SQUIRT AND PEE WEE HOUSE, ALSO FOR SQUIRT A & AA TRAVEL. PEE WEE A & AA TRAVEL AND BANTAM B GAMES WILL CONSIST OF 3 – 15 MINUTE STOP TIME PERIODS. THE THIRD PERIOD OF ANY GAME WILL BECOME RUNNING TIME IF A FIVE GOAL MARGIN OR MORE IS REACHED AT ANYTIME AFTER THE END OF THE SECOND PERIOD. SCORE MUST BE REDUCED TO A THREE GOAL MARGIN FOR STOP TIME TO RESUME.
5. THIS IS A ROUND ROBIN TOURNAMENT CONSISTING OF 3 GAMES. AT THEIR CONCLUSION A WINNER AND RUNNER-UP FROM EACH DIVISION WILL BE DETERMINED TO PLAY A SEMI-FINAL GAME TO DETERMINE WHO WILL PLAY IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME (WINNER OF DIVISION 1 WILL PLAY RUNNER-UP OF DIVISION 2 AND WINNER OF DIVISION 2 WILL PLAY THE RUNNER-UP OF DIVISION 1). THE WINNERS OF THESE SEMI-FINAL GAMES WILL PLAY IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME. IF THERE ARE ONLY ENOUGH TEAMS FOR ONE DIVISION (FIVE TEAMS OR LESS) THEN WINNER AND RUNNER-UP OF THAT DIVISION WILL PLAY IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME, NO SEMI-FINAL GAMES WILL BE PLAYED.
6. THERE WILL BE NO OVERTIME IN REGULAR GAMES. SEMI-FINAL AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAMES, IF TIED AFTER REGULATION, WILL CONSIST OF 5-MINUTE SUDDEN DEATH OVERTIME PERIODS UNTIL THERE IS A WINNER.
7. TIE-BREAKER PROCEDURES:
 - 1) HEAD TO HEAD ACTION
 - 2) DIVISION RECORD
 - 3) LEAST GOALS ALLOWED
 - 4) GOAL DIFFERENTIAL
 - 5) GOALS FOR IN 3rd GAME
 - 6) GOALS FOR IN 2nd GAME
 - 7) COIN FLIP
8. ALL USA HOCKEY AND MAHA RULES WILL APPLY.
